WHAT: Each August, automotive enthusiasts and gourmands gather at the storied Quail Lodge in Carmel, Calif. for *The Quail, A Motorsports Gathering*, a day-long celebration of the luxury lifestyle. The sixth annual Quail will honor the *Twelve Hours of Sebring*, the United States' leading endurance race; the 25th anniversary of the *Porsche 959*, the first high-performance car to use an all-wheel-drive system; and *Eagle race cars*, honored for their outstanding performance and remarkable design by racing legend Dan Gurney. The Quail will also commemorate the career of storied test driver, *Valentino Balboni*, recognized for more than 30 years of work with Lamborghini.
